

HOW HOLLYWOOD HAS GROWN.

RAPID PROGRESS MADE IN TWO YEARS AND A HALF.

Specific Data Describing a Building Campaign that Has Few Equals in Suburban Advancement—The Rival "Ends" and What They Have Achieved.

Saturday's Times contained a sketch of progressive Hollywood, in the course of which aggregate figures were given showing the value of improvements made there during the past two years and a half. Supplementing that statement, the following details are now given, enumerating the building and other improvements made during the period named in the east and west ends, respectively, taking Cahuenga avenue as the center—as the point d'appui, so to speak. The estimates are as close as can be made from reliable data.
